

Objectives of the Assignment

This assignment supports the **EU-Africa Business Forum Facility** under the **Global Gateway strategy** and aims to strengthen the role of the **EBOWN African Cluster of EBOs** as a key platform for enhancing European competitiveness by supporting EU and EU Member States' economic diplomacy, advocacy, trade between Europe and Africa, and business partnerships for EU businesses across Africa.

Key Objectives

- A **Diagnostic Study Report** assessing the capacities and services of the EBOs in Africa and actionable strategies and roadmap to enhance EBO operations, sustainability and impact.
- A **tailored training roadmap** to strengthen the capabilities of EBOs, aligned with the Global Gateway strategy and Global Gateway Sector-Specific Topics.







Overview of Diagnostic study



Focus Areas of the Study

- 1. Institutional Capacity & Services
- → Quality and relevance of services (advocacy, B2B, forums, research)
- 2. Advocacy & Policy Engagement
- → Influence on policy, Public Private Dialogue, and alignment with EU Delegations
- 3. Sustainability & Strategic Alignment
- → Financial resilience, EU instrument use, and long-term positioning

How:

- Assess 18 EBOs in Africa to map strengths, gaps, and strategic alignment
- Evaluate service delivery, policy influence, sustainability, and use of EU instruments
- Gather insights from 18 EU Delegations & 36 African BSOs on collaboration effectiveness
- Design a capacity-building roadmap aligned with Global Gateway flagship priorities
- Facilitate a validation workshop (Nov 2025) to secure stakeholder input and endorsement
- Deliver a final report with practical recommendations and training pathways







Study Scope & Methodology



Diagnostic Study – Data Collection Summary

Surveys (via EBOWN Website)

- One online survey for EBOs
- Two additional questionnaires for EU Delegations and African BSOs (ABOs)

Stakeholder Interviews (72 Total via MS Teams)

- 18 EBOs (based on survey input)
- 18 EU Delegations (via EABF coordination)
- 36 African BSOs (nominated by EBOs; 2 per country)
- Led by Johanna (English) and Julien (French/Portuguese)

Case Studies (3 Minimum)

- Highlight strong practices in EBO service delivery, partnerships, and advocacy
- Selected based on impact, innovation, and replicability cases selected during the interview process







EBO Participation in the Diagnostic Study



Goals for EBO Participation in the Diagnostic Study

- 1. Complete the EBO Survey
 - Provide timely and thoughtful responses to the online survey to support the diagnostic assessment.
- 2. Nominate Key Contacts in African BSOs (ABOs)
 - Identify and recommend two relevant ABOs in your country for interviews, preferably organisations you collaborate with regularly.
- 3. Support Stakeholder Interviews
 - Be available for a structured interview via Microsoft Teams and encourage nominated ABOs to participate in individual interviews.
- 4. Share Strategic Insights
 - Engage in open discussions on priorities, advocacy experiences, and capacity needs to inform the study's findings.
- 5. Attend the Final Workshop (tentatively scheduled during the EU-AU Business Forum, Nov 2025)
 - Participate in the validation workshop to review results, provide feedback, and co-develop the capacity-building roadmap.
- 6. Are you able to finance participating in the validation workshop?
