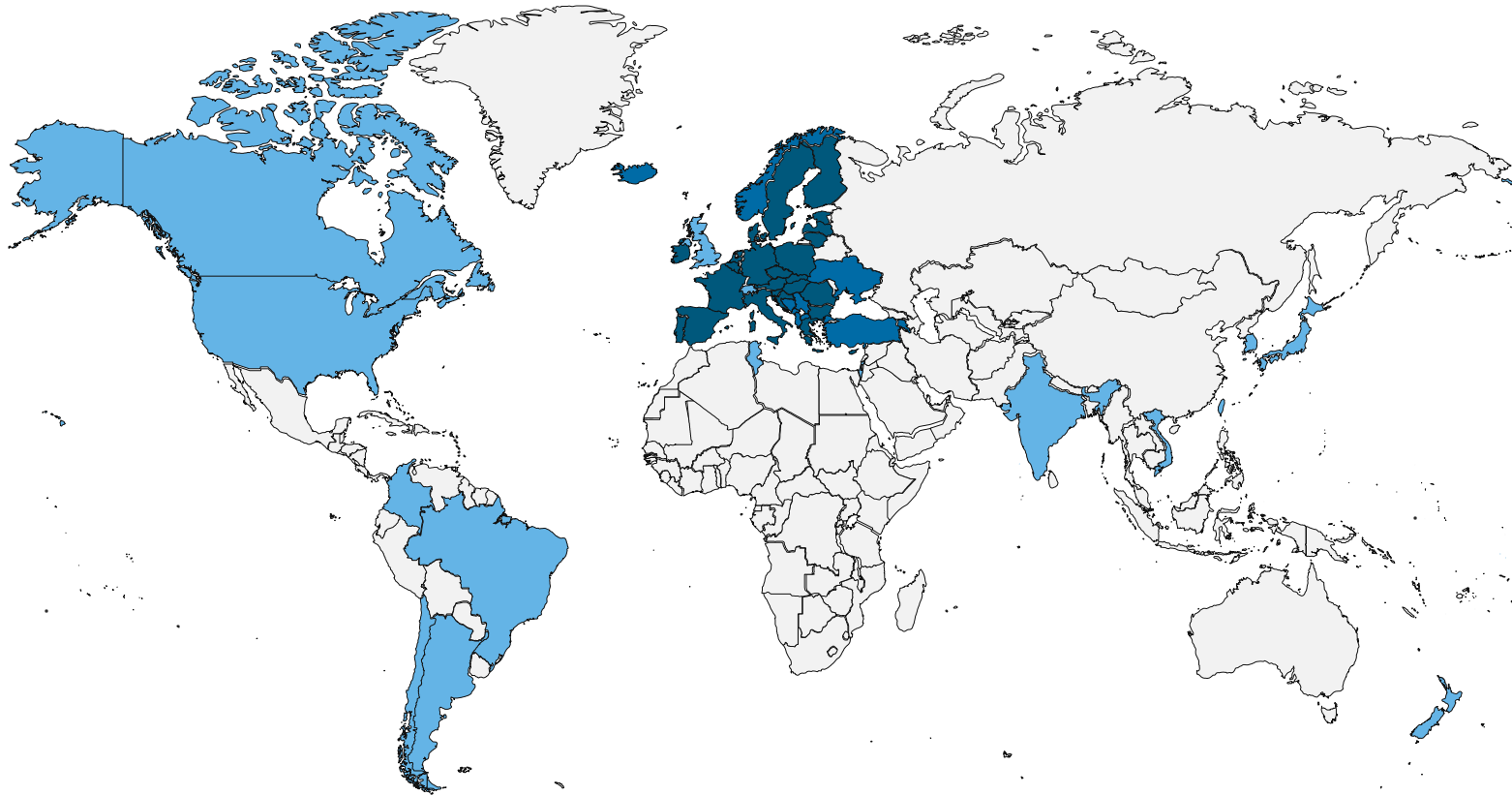

- No fee required by the EEN – no charge – no funding (*exception of moderate registration fees for matchmaking events at major local fairs)
- A consortium of 1 - 3 organisations (*larger consortia possible upon request)
- More than one consortium per country/region possible
- The local EU Delegation must provide a letter of support
- There is no deadline or cut-off dates! Contractual period ends 31 Dec 2028 (EOI from 01 July 2025 earliest – 31 December 2027 latest)
- INPs should always generate achievements together with EU-based Network partners
